

What is a Singles Box League?

Players are placed in Round Robin boxes with 4-5 players of a similar skill level. A player will arrange and play one match against each person within their box before the end of the month. Matches can be played any day and time that works for both player's schedules. After the deadline date the boxes will be reorganized based on player performance. Players may withdraw or join before the start of any round but will not be allowed to join once the round has begun.

— COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Throughout the pandemic Lakewood Indoor Tennis Centre has prioritized the health and safety of all members, program participants, guests, and staff. LITC's demographics, ranging from young children, who are not yet eligible for vaccination, to seniors and those who may be immune-compromised, are an important consideration in developing our COVID-19 policies.

As of October 1st, 2021, Lakewood Indoor Tennis Centre will require proof of vaccination for Covid-19 and a mask to access the facility in accordance with Saskatchewan Public Health Measures. This means that anyone age 18 and older will be required to provide proof of vaccination to the Front Desk in order to enter the club. Youth under the age of 18 are exempt from proof of vaccination if they are participating in sport, but must wear a mask. All guests and spectators must provide proof of vaccination and wear a mask at all times.

In addition to our Vaccination Policy, members, guests and staff will be required to continue following all existing Saskatchewan Health Authority Public Health & Safety policies such as the mandatory mask policy, physical distancing, and any other public health measures instituted by the province, and/ or the city.

We ask our members, program participants and guests to understand the pressures we are all facing during the pandemic. Please be kind and respectful of our staff. Any belligerent or aggressive behaviour or the refusal to obey public health orders will not be tolerated in our Centre.
